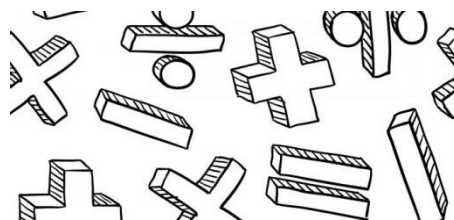
2pm - 4pm
